NORD Center For Dance, a partnership of the New Orleans Recreation Department and the New Orleans Ballet Association provides tuition-free, year-round comprehensive dance and fitness programs in Orleans Parish for youth ages 6-18 and senior citizens through sequential training and ancillary activities. With a core curriculum of ballet for youth and fitness dance classes for seniors, classes are dedicated to high artistic standards and rigorous curriculum & instruction to any child or senior citizen in Orleans Parish with a demonstrated interest in dance and fitness. The NORD Center for Dance encourages and regards students' artistic development and strengthens their life skills, persistence, self-discipline, and mutual respect. The program currently serves more than 350 students, each semester at 7 sites citywide. Through a professional faculty under the direction of the New Orleans Ballet Association, master classes, a mentor program and field trips, the Center works with each individual to cultivate dreams and strengthen futures.
